• Runway of Pride

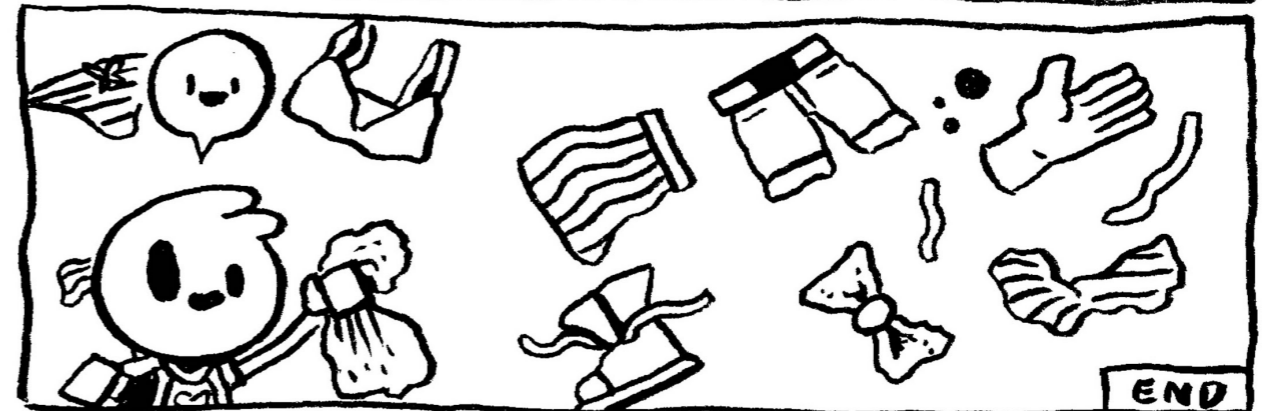
Strut and show us your most prideful walk on the rainbow carpet!
